Houston County SSTS grant funds are made available by the MPCA to replace failing subsurface sewage treatment systems. The grant funds are allocated on a first come first served basis to qualifying and approved applicants.

Please read the following carefully -

In order to qualify for grant funds, the following requirements must be met:

Qualifying Properties -

- Single family homes located entirely within Houston County that are not serviced by a municipal waste treatment facility.
- Property must be homesteaded.
- Have a failing septic system with a Notice of Noncompliance on file with Houston County prior to or at the time of application submission.

Qualifying Individuals/Households -

- Must meet low income requirements.
- Occupy the home for a minimum of 6 months prior to application.
- Household income must be at or lower than the limits listed below.
- Homeowner(s) must be occupying the home.
- Applicants will provide Houston County with the information requested and required in order for the application to be reviewed for eligibility.

(To determine eligibility, look at the # of persons in household. Your income tax return (Adjusted Gross Income) and other income must be at, or lower, than this number.)

Restrictions -

- Grant Funds <u>cannot</u> be used for the purpose of property transfer. Land owner is to repay cost-share funds paid by Houston County for the system if a property transfer occurs in less than 12 months from the issuance of funds.
- Construction of the septic system must not be started prior to the applicant(s) entering into a contract with Houston County.
- Grant funds cannot be used on rental properties.
- Must submit additional information if changes occur within the household during the application
 process, prior to entering into cost-share contract. (Loss of job, change in income, change in number
 of members in household).
- Cost-share funds are not to be used for increasing the square footage of the home, building or replacing of a home onto the property.
- Information provided to the Department must be true and complete.

How does the process work?

- Interested homeowners submit a complete SSTS Grant Fund Application to Houston County Environmental Services Department.
- There is no application fee associated with the SSTS Grant Fund Program.
- Department reviews all required materials for eligibility determination.
- When the application is found to be eligible Houston County Environmental Services staff will approve the application and the applicants will enter into a cost share contract.
- Cost Share Grant is limited to 50% of the total cost of the system, not to exceed \$10,000.00
- Houston County will release the funds once work is complete and a Certificate of Compliance has been issued.

Houston County Environmental Services staff will assist applicants during the application process, but applicants are responsible for making the choices and doing all of the listed items including, but not limited to, the following:

- Contractor selection shall be made on a competitive bid process. A minimum of two written competitive
 estimates are required for the installation of the designed system. The term "contractor" refers to
 Minnesota Pollution Control Agency licensed septic system designers, septic system installers, and other
 entities providing services to the abatement activities.
- Applicants, not staff, are responsible for entering into a contract with the contractor to do the work.
- Applicants are responsible for working with the contractors to settle any and all disagreements that may
 arise before, during, or after the job. If the applicant fails to abide by the Grant Agreement the applicant
 shall be responsible to the contractor for all contractually agreed upon terms, including payment,
 without any further remedy for damages or recovery against Houston County.
- Applicants and/or contractor will complete all the necessary permitting.
- Permit fees are to be paid at the time of the septic permit application submission.
