## **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

Law Enforcement Labor Services Local #415 and Houston County

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into between Houston County, Minnesota (hereafter "County"), and Law Enforcement Labor Services, Local #415 Inc. (hereafter, "Union").

Whereas, the County and the Union are parties to a Labor Agreement effective January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020 (hereafter "Agreement"); and

Whereas, the Grievant is a member of LELS Local #415; and

Whereas, on December 5, 2018, the Sheriff eliminated two Lieutenant positions; and

Whereas, the organizational changes resulted in the reassignment of the Grievant from Investigations Lieutenant to Deputy Sheriff effective December 5, 2018; and

Whereas, the Grievant filed a grievance on December 13, 2018 contesting the reorganization and subsequent reassignment to Deputy Sheriff as a punitive action; and

Whereas, the Grievant and the Union accept the Sheriff's Office restructuring and the reassignment of the Grievant; and

Whereas, the Grievant's effective pay rate for 2018 was adjusted to \$36.68 per hour (12% above Deputy pay) pursuant to settlement of both LELS Local #237 2018-2020 agreement and the parties' Agreement; and

Whereas, the parties desire to resolve the grievance.

**Now, therefore,** the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The December 13, 2018 grievance shall be withdrawn with prejudice; and
- 2. The Grievant shall remain in the reassigned position of Deputy Sheriff and remains eligible for future promotions; and
- 3. The Grievant's pay shall be \$37.69 per hour (11.75% above top Deputy Pay) effective January
- 1, 2019, including back pay to January 1, 2019, and frozen at this rate until such time as the Grievant's LELS Local #237 job class wage exceeds \$37.69 per hour; and
- 4. The Grievant shall not serve a probationary period or trial work period as a Deputy Sheriff; and
- 5. The County and the Union acknowledge that this agreement will not serve as precedent for resolving future disputes regarding organizational restructuring and/or involuntary demotions; and
- 6. This Memorandum of Agreement represents the complete and total agreement between the parties regarding this matter.
