### **Deputy Sheriff Application Directions**

Houston Co. is currently accepting applications for one or more full-time Deputy Sheriff positions.

#### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLYING:**

1. Applicants must possess a valid MN Peace Officer's License; or be POST license eligible by the date of hire. Proof of licensure or eligibility must be included with the application materials. Proof of reciprocity from POST may also be accepted for out of state applicants and must also be provided. **Failure to provide proof of licensure, eligibility or reciprocity from POST will render your application incomplete and it will not be considered further!** Questions regarding licensure, eligibility or reciprocity should be directed to the Minnesota Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) Board at (651) 643-3060; or see <https://dps.mn.gov/entity/post/contact/Pages/default.aspx>
2. Possess or eligible to obtain a valid Minnesota Driver's License.
3. Shall not have been convicted of a felony in this state or any other state or in any federal jurisdiction, or an offense in any other state or federal jurisdiction, which would have been a felony if committed in the State of MN.
4. Must be free from any physical condition, which might adversely affect the individual's duties as a Peace Officer.
