Call to order.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Walter, seconded by Commissioner Myhre, motion unanimously carried to approve the agenda. The closed session was removed from the agenda, and tabled until the following week.

Motion was made by Commissioner Walter, seconded by Commissioner Severson, motion unanimously carried to approve the board meeting minutes from June 1, 2021.

Public Comment: No public comments were made.

Public Health and Human Services Director Pugleasa provided an update on the COVID-19 pandemic and response from Public Health and Human Services. Pugleasa stated that cases in Houston County remained flat. He said 99.1% of the County's 65 and older population had been vaccinated. He also shared that 57% of the County's total population had been vaccinated. Houston County continued to be in the top ten Counties in the State for vaccination rates. Pugleasa said he was grateful to community volunteers and other community partners for their efforts in vaccinating Houston County residents.

**CONSENT AGENDA** 

Commissioner Johnson moved, Commissioner Myhre seconded, motion unanimously carried to approve the consent agenda. Items approved are listed below.

- 1) Hire Dylan Felten, as a probationary Appraiser Trainee B22, Step 1, effective June 9, 2021, conditioned upon satisfactory completion of a background check.
- 2) Confirm the resignation of Olivia Denney, Emergency Management Coordinator, effective May 28, 2021.
- 3) Approve the State of Minnesota and Houston County 2022 Sentence to Serve Agreement.
- 4) Approve Peddler's License Applications for three applicants: Ries Bohr, Joshua Loso, and Riley Smith.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

File No. 1 – Commissioner Johnson moved, Commissioner Severson seconded, motion unanimously carried to approve an IUP for Mathy Construction for a Temp Bituminous Plant in Spring Grove Township. The motion included adopting the Planning Commission's findings and included four conditions: 1. The permittee shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations; 2. The County may enter onto the premises at reasonable times in a reasonable manner to ensure the permit holder is in compliance with the conditions and all other applicable statutes, rules, and ordinances; 3. Runoff from within the plant footprint shall be contained within the existing quarry floor; 4. Permit expiration shall be December 31, 2021.

File No. 2 – Commissioner Myhre moved, Commissioner Severson seconded, motion unanimously carried to approve a CUP for Joseph Baxter for a non-farm dwelling in Jefferson Township. The motion included adopting the Planning Commission's findings and included three conditions: 1. The permittee shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations; 2. The County may enter onto the premises at reasonable times in a reasonable manner to ensure the permit holder is in compliance with the conditions and all other applicable statutes, rules, and ordinances; 3. Thirty-three feet of owned or easement access to the public road is required prior to any building permit issuance.

File No. 3 – Commissioner Johnson moved, Commissioner Walter seconded, motion carried to approve a CUP for Matt and Marcia Welch for a non-farm dwelling in Houston Township. All members voted in favor except for Chairperson Burns who abstained due to a family relation. The motion included adopting the Planning Commission's findings and included two conditions: 1. The permittee shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations; 2. The County may enter onto the premises at reasonable times in a reasonable manner to ensure the permit holder is in compliance with the conditions and all other applicable statutes, rules, and ordinances.

File No. 4 – Commissioner Myhre moved, Commissioner Johnson seconded, motion unanimously carried to approve a CUP for William Gerdes to operate a farm outlet to sell milk/farm products in Caledonia Township. The motion included adopting the Planning Commission's findings and included two conditions: 1. The permittee shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations; 2. The County may enter onto the premises at

reasonable times in a reasonable manner to ensure the permit holder is in compliance with the conditions and all other applicable statutes, rules, and ordinances.

File No. 5 – Commissioner Severson moved, Commissioner Johnson seconded, motion unanimously carried to accept a quote from Heating and Cleaning Solutions, LLC for the pressure washer for the new Highway Shop Building for \$9,007.43.

File No. 6 – Commissioner Severson moved, Commissioner Johnson seconded, motion unanimously carried to approve Change Order Request No. 10 for the Highway Department Building. The change order was to provide an electrical vault (basement) below the main service transformer as a requirement by the electric utility company.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Commissioners had a discussion with Adam Augedhal, Dave Augedahl, and Engineer Pogodzinski regarding a building and driveway belonging to Adam Augedahl on County Highway 10. Chairperson Burns said the initial garage was built below base flood elevation. A County permit had been issued before the garage was built. Commissioners discussed with the Augedahls the previous permit that had been issued, and possible changes to the road that would affect the slope of the current driveway. No formal decisions were made on the topic and the Commissioners said they would revisit the topic at the next regular meeting.

Commissioners discussed recent meetings they had attended including an AMC District Meeting, Extension Meeting, and Highway Department Meeting. Commissioner Walter shared she had attended a Community Health Meeting with Veteran Services and Human Services. She also shared she had received some information from the National Association of Counties (NACO) regarding the American Rescue Plan dollars counties would be receiving and would share the information with the other Commissioners and County staff. Commissioner Severson told the board he would be out of State for the next regular meeting and would be attending the meeting remotely via zoom. Commissioner Myhre asked about the overall County Highway Shop building timeline and budget. Engineer Pogodzinski said that they were hoping for a move in date of early to mid December 2021. The Highway Shop project was still within the initial budget, and they had not had to use any of the contingency funds to date.

There being no further business at 10:47 a.m., a motion was made by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Severson, motion unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting. The next meeting would be a workgroup session on June 15, 2021.

Board Workgroup Session

Call to order.

Visitors Jeff Lewis and Noah Kramer from Schneider introduced themselves to the Commissioners. They shared that they do work on Beacon, the County's geographic information system (GIS). Their work included parcel splits, addressing, permitting, and visualizations.

Commissioners discussed potential broadband projects in Houston County with representatives from AcenTek and Spring Grove Communications. Broadband was an eligible use of American Rescue Plan (ARP) dollars under the infrastructure category.

Commissioners discussed the ARP dollars the County was anticipating receiving, and possible uses for the funds. They asked department heads to start putting together numbers for potential qualifying projects. The Treasury's deadline submit comments on the ARP would be July 16, 2021. After the comment period the Treasury would be finalizing the guidelines for the funds. Funds would need to be incurred and obligated by December 31, 2024. Funds needed to be expended to cover obligations and all work needed to be completed by December 31, 2026.

Commissioners discussed the property located at 315 South Chase Street in Houston. Auditor/Treasurer Trehus said no one had attended the recent auction to bid on the property. She

recommended lowering the minimum bid amount to \$8,000.00 and advertising an auction again. The Commissioners agreed.

Commissioners briefly discussed additional items including an engineered plan for the steps at the Historic County Courthouse, repairs that were needed on the second floor of the Historic Courthouse, the Historic Courthouse roof and possible grant funding, Highway Department projects, and a future road project on County Highway 10 near Adam Augedahl's property.

The meeting was adjured at 11:33 a.m.

## PURCHASE CONTRACT FOR MOSQUITO ABATEMENT SERVICES

#### I. PARTIES.

This Contract is made and entered into this 8th day of June, 2021 by and between Driftless Region Vector Control LLC, hereinafter referred to as Provider, and Houston County, Minnesota, hereinafter referred to as Purchaser.

Provider's employee responsible for administration of this Contract will be Joseph Writz, Owner of Driftless Region Vector Control LLC, whose principal address is PO Box 2722, La Crosse, WI 54602.

Purchaser's employee responsible for administration of this Contract will be Heather Myhre, Public Health Supervisor, whose principal address is 611 Vista Drive, Suite 1, Caledonia, MN 55921.

### II. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED AND CONTRACT PERIOD.

- a. Purchaser has an endemic area for arboviruses that are dangerous to the health and well being of its residents, and wishes to purchase services to address the issue. Provider is experienced with the elimination and abatement of mosquitoes that can bear the La Crosse strain of Encephalitis and other arboviruses, and can provide these services.
- b. Provider will provide services to canvass communities for potential mosquitorelated human health hazards, identify and larvicide habitat sites for mosquito abatement, and provide Purchaser with list of found sites and activities, in Houston County.

Communities/Areas to canvass include:

Eitzen, Golfview Dr Area (west of Hokah), Hokah, Houston, Money Creek, Outer La Crescent (residential area just outside western city limits).

- c. When a potential mosquito-related human health hazard site is identified (seen from the road or complaint site), Provider will follow these steps:
  - 1. Attempt to communicate with owner of property where habitat is located. Provider will leave the property if instructed by property owner and will not enter posted property or properties with aggressive people or animals.
  - 2. Educate owner and provide pamphlet about the issue.
  - 3. Check habitat for mosquito presence and treat with larvicide.
  - 4. Keep record of all information obtained at the site.

- 5. Notify Purchaser about sites when permission is not given to check and treat habitat.
- d. Provider will fully canvass communities listed in II. b. once. The sites found in the initial canvassing will be rechecked twice to update the site list. If Provider is given a letter of permission or authority by Purchaser, non-compliant sites may be entered and human health hazards may be treated during rechecks if no immediate contact is made.
- e. Provider may also set up and monitor ovitraps throughout Purchaser's County designed to collect and remove the eggs of vector mosquito species in coordination with Purchaser's officials.
- f. Purchaser agrees to purchase and Provider agrees to provide the above described mosquito abatement services during the period of:

#### June 8, 2021 to December 31, 2021

#### III. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES.

- Purchaser agrees to pay Provider for the services provided in accordance with this Contract.
- b. Purchaser will pay compensation to Provider for Services in the amount of \$2,500. Payments will be made as follows:

- c. Purchaser will pay Provider within 30 days of the payment date.
- d. If Purchaser requests additional services from Provider, Purchaser will provide additional resources to Provider.

#### IV. INSURANCE.

- a. Purchaser shall not provide insurance coverage of any kind for Provider or Provider's employees or contract personnel. Provider shall obtain the following insurance coverage and maintain it during the entire term of this Contract:
  - Automobile liability insurance for each vehicle used in the performance of this Contract -- including owned, non-owned (for example, owned by Provider's employees), leased, or hired vehicles -- in the minimum amount of \$1.5 million combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

# REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FRAUD PREVENTION INVESTIGATION PROGRAM

This Agreement by and between <u>WABASHA</u> County Human Services, acting as the lead agency for the regional Fraud Prevention Investigation (FPI) program (hereinafter REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY) and <u>HOUSTON</u> County through its Human Services Department (hereinafter COUNTY AGENCY).

WHEREAS, the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY contracts with the State of Minnesota's Department of Human Services, Financial Fraud and Abuse Investigations Division (hereinafter STATE) to administer the FPI program in <u>HOUSTON</u> County, under contract number <u>GRK% 194359</u> which is incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the intent of this Agreement achieves mutually beneficial goals by establishing the organizational and operational structures for providing FPI services to counties in a geographical area in accordance with operational requirements, forms and reporting mechanisms as contained in the FPI Program Guidelines (FPI Guidelines) which are incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed:

#### 1. TERM OF AGREEMENT.

- 1.1 Effective date. The effective date of this Agreement is 07/01/2021.
- 1.2 Expiration date. The expiration date of this Agreement is 06/30/2023.

#### 2. COUNTY AGENCY DUTIES. The COUNTY AGENCY will:

- 2.1 Cooperate with the STATE and the FPI REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY in fulfilling goals and objectives of the FPI Program pursuant to the FPI Guidelines, United States laws, federal regulations, State of Minnesota (State or state) laws, applicable Department rules and county ordinances.
- 2.2 Cooperate with the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY in monitoring fraud referrals, completed investigations and case actions taken as a result of fraud prevention investigations.
- 2.3 Cooperate with the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY and the STATE in submission of narrative, financial and/or statistical reports either as required in FPI Guidelines or as requested by the STATE.
- 2.4 Ensure that eligibility workers under its control make FPI referrals to the investigator representing the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY, cooperate with case action reporting requirements and participate in funded FPI program related training.
- 2.5 Evaluate FPI referral rates among COUNTY AGENCY eligibility workers in order to help identify fraud detection training needs.
- 2.6 Refer for criminal prosecution public assistance recipients and providers who have committed intentional program violations (IPV) or, when such prosecutions are declined by a COUNTY AGENCY attorney or the COUNTY AGENCY decides not to pursue criminal

prosecution of an IPV, pursue administrative disqualification of a provider or recipient in lieu of criminal prosecution in compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 256.046.

- 3. REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY DUTIES. The REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY will:
  - 3.1 Provide FPI services and report FPI Program activity to the COUNTY AGENCY.
  - 3.2 Use qualified investigative staff to provide FPI services.
  - 3.3 Annually provide training to COUNTY AGENCY eligibility workers in fraud detection to assist them in identifying cases that should be referred. Provide training to COUNTY AGENCY eligibility workers on FPI forms and procedures.
  - 3.4 Assist the COUNTY AGENCY in the identification and disqualification of individuals through the administrative disqualification hearing process when a completed fraud prevention investigation identifies an intentional program violation and no criminal action is contemplated.
- 4. **CONSIDERATION AND PAYMENT.** There will be no funds paid out by either agency under this Agreement. Each agency will be responsible for its own costs in performing its stated duties.
- 5. AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES,
  - 5.1 **REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY.** The REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY's authorized representative is **John Dahlstrom** or his/her successor.
  - 5.2 **COUNTY AGENCY.** The COUNTY AGENCY's authorized representative is <u>John Pugleasa</u> or his/her successor.
- 6. **ASSIGNMENT.** COUNTY AGENCY shall neither assign nor transfer any rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY.
- 7. **AMENDMENTS.** Any amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be executed by the same parties who executed the original Agreement, or their successors in office.
- 8. <u>CANCELLATION.</u> This Agreement may be canceled by the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY or COUNTY AGENCY at any time, with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
- 9. STATE AUDITS. Under Minn. Stat. §16C.05, subd. 5, the books, records, documents, and accounting procedures and practices of the COUNTY AGENCY and its employees, agents, or subcontractors relevant to this contract shall be made available and subject to examination by the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY and STATE, including the FPI contracting Agency/Division, Legislative Auditor, and State Auditor for a minimum of six years from the end of this Agreementt.
- 10. INFORMATION PRIVACY AND SECURITY. For purposes of executing its responsibilities and to the extent set forth in this Agreement, the COUNTY AGENCY will be processing health care bills or payments on behalf of the State, and/or conducting other health care operations on behalf of State. In carrying out its duties, COUNTY AGENCY will be handling protected health information and other private information concerning individual State clients. As such, COUNTY AGENCY

agrees to be bound by the state and federal laws protecting the privacy of information, including the Data Practices Act, Minnesota Health Records Act, Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA), Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act (HITECH) (42 USC 201 note, 42 USC 17931), and federal drug and alcohol treatment regulations.

Because COUNTY AGENCY is handling protected health information and providing health care services to clients on behalf of State, COUNTY AGENCY must comply with the terms of the information Privacy Agreement signed by its County Administrator and the STATE, which is on file in the State Privacy Official's Office located at State's Central Office, 540 Cedar Street, St. Paul, MN 55164-0998 and is incorporated herein by reference.

- 11. LIABILITY. The COUNTY AGENCY and the REGIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY agree that each party will be responsible for its own acts and the results thereof to the extent authorized by law and shall not be responsible for the acts of the other and the results thereof. #### VI. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS.

- a. Subject to terms and conditions of this Contract, Purchaser hereby engages Provider as an independent contractor to perform the services set forth herein, and Provider hereby accepts such engagement.
- b. This Contract shall not render Provider an employee, partner, agent of, or joint venturer with Purchaser for any purpose. Provider is and will remain an independent contractor in relationship to Purchaser. Purchaser shall not be responsible for withholding taxes with respect to Provider's compensation hereunder. Provider shall have no claim against Purchaser hereunder or otherwise for vacation pay, sick leave, retirement benefits, social security, worker's compensation, health or disability benefits, unemployment insurance benefits, or employee benefits of any kind.
- c. Provider has the right to perform services for others during the term of this Contract.
- d. Provider has the sole right to control and direct the means, manner, and method by which the services required by this Contract will be performed. Provider shall select the routes taken, starting and quitting times, days of work, and order the work is performed.
- e. Provider has the right to hire assistants as subcontractors or to use employees to provide the services required by this Contract.
- f. Neither Provider nor Provider's employees or contract personnel shall be required to wear any uniforms provided by Purchaser.
- g. The services required by this Contract shall be performed by Provider, Provider's employees, or contract personnel, and Purchaser shall not hire, supervise, or pay any assistants to help Provider.

- h. Neither Provider nor Provider's employees or contract personnel shall receive any training from Purchaser in the professional skills necessary to perform the services required by this Contract.

#### VIII. DATA PRACTICES COMPLIANCE.

a. Provider will have access to data collected or maintained by Purchaser to the extent necessary to perform Provider's obligations under this Contract. #### IX. SEVERABILITY.

a. If any provision of this Contract will be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions will continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provision of this Contract is invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting such provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision will be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited.

#### X. CONTRACT REVISION AND/OR TERMINATION.

  - iii. Committing embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements or receiving stolen property; and
- 4. Are not aware of any information and possess no knowledge that any subcontractor(s) that will perform work pursuant to this Contract are in violation of any of the certifications set forth above.
- 5. Shall immediately give written notice should Provider come under investigation for allegations of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, or performing: a public (federal, state or local government) transaction; violating any federal or state antitrust statutes; or committing embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements or receiving stolen property.
- c. "Principals" for the purpose of this certification means officers; directors; owners; partners; and persons having primary management or supervisor responsibilities within a business entity (e.g., general manager; plant manager; head of a subsidiary, division, or business segment and similar positions).
